Mother & Unborn Baby Care

Mother and Unborn Baby Care (MAUBC) is a place where women can find an alternative to abortion when facing a crisis pregnancy. MAUBC is a non-profit organization whose mission is to save babies from abortion by offering help, encouragement and counseling to women facing crisis pregnancies. All services at the MAUBC Problem Pregnancy Center are free. Located in Lathrup Village, the Center is open 5 days a week and Saturdays by appointment. The counseling services are pro-life, honest, informative and sensitive to the emotional, spiritual and material needs of the mother. MAUBC uses its own resources, as well as making referrals to other community agencies to make it easier for women to give their babies the gift of life. Columbian Squires Regina Angelorum No. 1426 Open to Catholic boys ages 10-17

Working with Knights of Columbus, Squires bring boys together with people in need. For example, while Knights cooked and supervised, Squires delivered hot Easter meals to poor and homeless of Detroit. While Knights collected sweatshirt donations and chauffeured, Squires meet, mingled, and handed Christmas gifts to teenagers "doing time" in prison alternatives. Squires visit and pray regularly with the handicapped of Mary's Children Family Center, and they put muscle into their support of the Southfield Crisis Pregnancy Center. Squires programs offer opportunities for leadership and peer mentoring. Monthly planning meetings are run by duly elected **Chief Squire Kevin Palmer**.
